This is for information of all concerned that the **M.A. Semester-IV Examination, 2020 [academic Session 2018 – 2019 (Fresh), 2017-2018 (Supplementary and Readmitted)] in Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Vocal Music** under the Centre for Distance and Online Education of the University will be conducted after 20th December, 2021 in the blended mode (offline+online) as per resolutions adopted by the Examination Task Force in its emergency meeting held on 25.11.2021 on the basis of the UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of COVID-19 Pandemic, [vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 29th April, 2020] and UGC Revised Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for the Universities in view of COVID- 19 Pandemic [vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 6th July, 2020].

**Detailed modalities of M.A. Semester-IV Examination 2020, academic Session 2018 – 2019 (Fresh), 2017-2018 (Supplementary and Readmitted) are mentioned below:**

**(A).Theoretical Papers (under Faculty of Arts and Fine Arts)**

Bengali	Dissertation of Course 4.5 is to be submitted through “Web portal for students” on the website of the RBU, CDOE as per examination schedule. Word limit of the Dissertation report is 1500-2000. Dates of submission of Dissertation will be informed through subsequent notification.

**(C) Practical Examinations (Under Faculty of Fine Arts)**

Vocal Music	Online Practical Examination and Viva-voce of course 4.2, 4.3, 4.4 will be taken by the respective examiners using “Web portal for students” on the website of the RBU, CDOE as per examination schedule. Dates of practical will be informed through subsequent notification.

**(C) Dissertation (Under Faculty of Fine Arts)**

Vocal Music	Dissertation of Course 4.5 is to be submitted through “Web portal for students” on the website of the RBU, CDOE as per examination schedule. Word limit of the Dissertation report is 500-700. Dates of submission of Dissertation will be informed through subsequent notification.

**General Instruction for the students who will be appearing blended mode (online and offline)  
M.A. Semester-IV Examination 2020, academic Session 2018 – 2019 (Fresh), 2017-2018  
(Supplementary and Readmitted)**

1. Centre for Distance and Online Education of the University will announce the detailed schedule of Examination in due course of time. Students are required to visit the University website: [www.rbudde.in](http://www.rbudde.in) regularly. Students have to register in the student Portal available in the website of the CDOE, RBU ([www.rbudde.in](http://www.rbudde.in)), for appearing Blended Mode (Online + Offline) M.A. Semester-IV Examination, 2019.
2. In case a student of M.A. Semester-IV is unable to appear in the blended mode (online + offline) conducted by the University for whatsoever the reason may be, he/she will be given opportunity to appear in special examinations for such course(s), which shall be conducted by the university as and when feasible. This provision shall be applicable as one-time measure.
3. Candidates (‘Persons with Benchmark Disabilities’), ‘who want to write Examination with Scribe may apply ( as per Format attached) to the Joint Registrar (Exam) using University designated portal at the time of online Examination Form fill up process with all necessary document of the candidate and the Scribe.
4. Students have to submit examination form through “web portal for students”, for appearing in the M.A. Semester-IV Examination, 2020 (Academic Seccession 2018-19, 2017-18).
5. In case a student is unable to fill up and submit the ‘Enrollment Cum Examination Form’ through online mode as per schedule given by the University, for whatsoever the reason(s) may be, he/she will not be able to appear in the M.A. Semester-IV Examination, 2020 (Academic Seccession 2018-19, 2017-18).
